A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- To amend Code Section 20-3-519 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions applicable to HOPE scholarships and grants, so as to change the definition of the term "eligible high school"; to thereby change conditions of eligibility for HOPE scholarships and grants; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
- SECTION 1.
- Code Section 20-3-519 of the Official Code of Georgia 1-10 Annotated, relating to definitions applicable to HOPE 1-12 scholarships and grants, is amended by striking in its
